 - b. Menstrual Cycle ...3 points
 - What is menstruation?
 - Why is it important?
 - What is the hormone that begins this process?
 - c. Fertilization.... 4 points
 - What is fertilization?
 - What are sperm?
 - How do sperm move?
 - Why are sperm important in this process?
- 4. Use at least one colored symbols, pictures, or drawings to grab the interest of the student that helps them understand the information better.
