1. Create an informational pamphlet for a group of **5th graders** (10-11 year olds)
2. Be sure as you create your pamphlet that you are being sensitive to the audience (both girls and boys) and using appropriate terminology
3. You need to include this information using **age-appropriate** terminology

a. Puberty....12 points

- What is puberty?
- What are 5 characteristics of puberty in the males?
- What are 5 characteristics of puberty in the females?
- Why is it important to know about this now?

b. Menstrual Cycle ...3 points

- What is menstruation?
- Why is it important?
- What is the hormone that begins this process?

c. Fertilization.... 4 points

- What is fertilization?
- What are sperm?
- How do sperm move?
- Why are sperm important in this process?

4. Use at least one colored symbols, pictures, or drawings to grab the interest of the student that helps them understand the information better.

5. Give your pamphlet a nice catchy title (and make sure it is attractive, interesting and age-appropriate.) **TITLE: 5 points**
